

- Training in specific aspects or skills within software engineering.


Aims



As one of four copyright libraries in the UK, NLW receives a copy of all books published in Wales. With an archive of over 4 million artefacts, NLW decided to digitise their collection for reasons of conservation and restoration as well as making items more available to the public via the Internet.
